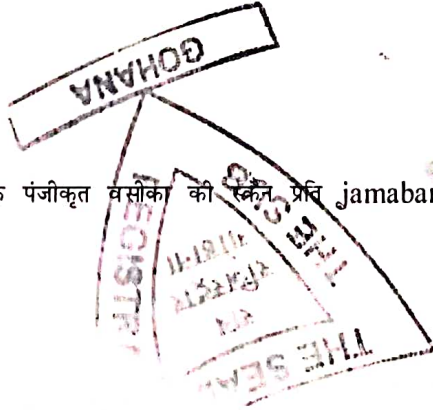

WHEREAS THE FOUNDER IS DESIROUS OF ESTABLISHING A TRUST FOR PUBLIC CHARITABLE OBJECTS.

AND WHEREAS THE TRUSTEES HAVE, AT THE REQUEST OF THE FOUNDER, AGREED TO ACT AS THE FIRST TRUSTEES OF THESE PRESENTS AS TESTIFIED BY THIER BEING PARTIES TO AND EXECUTING THESE PRESENTS.

AND WHEREAS IT IS NECESSARY TO DECLARE THE OBJECTS AND TERMS OF THE PUBLIC CHARITABLE TRUST, BEING CONSTITUTED UNDER THESE PRESENTS.

NOW THIS INDENTURE WITNESSTH AS FOLLOWS:

1. DECLARATION:-

That I undersigned do hereby declare that I have irrevocably settled an amount of Rs. 5100/- (Rupees Five Thousand and One Hundred only) for the sole purpose that it should form the nucleus and corpus fund of the trust and that it has been accepted by the Trustees who have consented to act as Trustees subject to conditions hereinafter stated.

2. TRUST NAME : CHAUDHARY LAHRI SINGH EDUCATIONAL & WELFARE TRUST

3. ADDRESS OF REGD. OFFICE: VILLAGE GANGANA TEHSIL GOHANA (SONIPAT)

4. NATURE OF THE TRUST: Public Charitable Trust

5. AREA OF TRUST : All over India

6. OBJECTS AND ACTIVITIES OF THE TRUST:

To accomplish the above objectives the trust shall do any or all of the following :-

- 1) To construct Temples, Dharamshala, Satsang Bhawan and to organize satsang, kirtan, Bhajan Sandhya, awareness programmes etc.
- 2) To establish, provided, maintain and conduct Research Centers, Laboratories, Training Colleges, Schools & other Institutions for the training and education in the field of medicals and natural science to needy students.
- 3) To undertake and carry out research projects, surveys, rural and agricultural development programs, environment protection, energy conservation, self or jointly with private agencies, Governments and the Nations of the world.
- 4) To undertake educational activities and for the purpose to construct, run and maintain schools, colleges and educational centers and to maintain vehicles to carry students.
- 5) To start the different kinds of family welfare and community health programme for the benefit of General Public.
- 6) To promote the adult education, child and welfare programme for the benefit of General Public.
- 7) To start the training and educational programmed in the field of medical education and other allied ancillary activities.
- 8) To provide, economic and social facilities directly or indirectly to poor sections of society such as facilities for drinking water, food, employment education, clothing, medicine. For their benefit to found, establish, maintain, organize, run, supervise, control, aid hostels, orphanages, old age homes, shelter house, dispensaries, sanatoriums and such other services.
- 9) To run Hospitals, Dispensaries and Medical Camps etc, so as to provide health services to weaker section of the society.

- 10) To provide education to poor and helpless children.
- 11) To run educational institutions including Schools, Medical College, Nursing school and colleges, Homeopathy College, Ayurveda College and Academic College, research institutes for the research of medicines for non-curable diseases.
- 12) To establish and maintain Cultural Centre to promote ancient cultural heritage of India.
- 13) To establish and maintain/co operate/ and amalgamate with other charitable Institutes, Trusts, Societies, bodies engaged towards alleviating sufferings and for advancement of human knowledge and happiness.
- 14) To establish Yoga Research Centre for analyses the relation of Yoga with Zoo-science and Human Physiology and to create natural health spa.
- 15) To organize Health check up camps, Blood Donation Camps etc.
- 16) To provide cooking, eating and other utensils or clothing temporarily from time to time to people who are for any reasons incapable for providing these for themselves at times of need.
- 17) To promote spiritual studies and open spiritual training and Yoga Centers for general public and to do every thing to make spiritual studies popular amongst the public.
- 18) To start, maintain and assist in relief measures in those parts which are or become subjected to natural calamities like famine, fire, flood, earthquakes etc.
- 19) To establish, found and maintain libraries, reading rooms for the use and convenience of general public.
- 20) To work to grow and save plants and environment and float a lush green environment to mankind and to enhance the forestry to save the natural environment.

- 21) To train, organize, promote, classical devotional musical programs and concerts, training centers for unity, peaceful living and for the welfare of society.
- 22) To establish, maintain, run, supervise and control widow houses for providing protection, upliftment and financial assistance.
- 23) To organize and run camps to promote de-addictions.
- 24) To purchase or construct or take on lease any land or building and to sale any land or building for obtaining the objects of the trust and relief to poor and weaker section of the society.
- 25) To accept donation from the public, Local Bodies and the governments or raise subscriptions from the members of the trust or other persons to invest the funds of the trust with such individuals, societies, firms or companies, banks for providing income to the trust, on such terms and conditions as may deem proper and necessary for the fulfillment of the aims and objects of the trust and to further its interest as enumerated above.
- 26) To Purchase movable and immovable properties to achieve the objects of the trust.
- 27) To donate, contribute to any other trust, society or project on such terms and conditions as may deem proper & necessary for the fulfillment of the aims & objects of the trust & further its interest as enumerated above.
- 28) To do any other act or thing which is ancillary to the achievement of any of the above stated objects.
- 29) To train bring up students according to ancient Indian culture and to give them Education according to the Modern and Scientific methods.
- 30) To spread Education in any part of India.
- 31) To give the property of the Trust on lease or rent and the income derived there from shall be used for the benefit of the society.

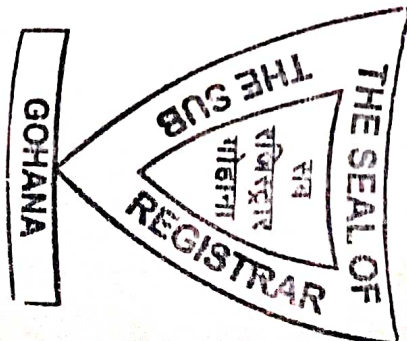
32) To raise loan or collect funds in the form of donations for the achievement of aim and objects of Trust.

33) To do all such other lawful acts and deeds as the Trust may deem incidental or conducive to the attaining of the objects of the trust or any of them.

7. BOARD OF TRUSTEES: -

The board of trustees shall consist of at least Five numbers. The day to day business of the trust shall be conducted by its president All business of the trust shall be in accordance with the guidelines and resolutions of the board of trustees. The names of the trustees are as follows:-

8. BENEFICIARIES:-

All the mankind without discrimination on the basis of religion, caste, colour, cred or sex shall be beneficiaries of this trust. The trust shall exist solely for philanthropic purpose and not for the purpose of profit.

9. TRUST FUND:-

The trust fund will contain the initial corpus as stated herein and also any funds, contribution by well-wishers, institutions and other voluntary agencies, NGO donors, aid/grants from any Government, subscriptions from participants received for furtherance of the objects upon such terms and conditions as the trustees may at their absolute discretion accept such contributions, as long as they are not inconsistent with the objects of the trust.

10. TENURE OF THE TRUSTEES

The founder of the trust, and other founder office bearer of the trust, shall remain at their post of the trust respectively for the duration of **three years**. The managing committee shall continue to govern the affairs of the trust till next election taken place, and the term of the present managing committee shall be extended by six months. New trustees can be admitted by a unanimous vote of the board of trustees and they shall remain as trustees for their whole lives. After the departure (demise) of the honorable President or any office bearers, the next president and other office bearers shall be elected by majority of vote of the serving trustees.

11. REMOVAL OF BOARD MEMBER

A board member may be removed by simple majority of vote after proper investigation if he misbehaves, conducts immoral life style or misappropriates the trust property or the activities of the member are against the trust.

12. QUORUM OF THE BOARD MEETING

The board shall hold at least one meeting in six months reviewing the affairs of the trust. Meeting may be called by giving at least seven days notice to all the trustees. The emergency meeting may be called by giving notice before 24 hours. At least 2/3 of the total trustees shall form Quorum for meeting of board of trustees. All decision and resolution except resolution changing the constitution shall require a simple majority of trustees present at the meeting. The resolution change the constitution shall require 2/3 majority of trustees present at the meeting.

13. POWER OF BOARD OF TRUSTEES

1. Board of Trustees shall have the power to receive donations so as to augment the Trust Funds or to treat such donation for the purpose of the Trust either towards corpus or other funds eligible to be spent or applied according to the object of the Trusts.
2. Board of Trustees shall have the power to invest the funds in best possible manner with a view to augment the resources of the Trust to be able to better fulfill the objects of the Trust, but the Trust will not embark on any business or invest in any speculative venture.

3. The Trustees will be entitled to accumulate the income for the objects of the Trust and to apply the same either out of the funds or the income for purposes of the Trust to the extent considered prudent and necessary during the year subject to any regulations governing such accumulation under any law for the time being in force.
4. Board of Trustee shall have power to convert the trust property, acquire immovable property, sell, charge-rent out or otherwise alienate the assets including immovable property for protecting or improving the Trust property or any object of the Trust.
5. Trustees will have powers to engage, suspend or dismiss employees or to take such other action to ensure proper management. It will have all powers necessary and incidental for management and administration of the Trust and its properties.
6. Board of Trustees shall have the power to delegate their duties to any of themselves or to employees, co-trustees and committees.
7. Board of Trustees may invite any employee, expert or well wisher to attend Trust Board meeting for advice and participation without right to vote.
8. All properties, whether movable or immovable, whether owned or entrusted to the Trust by Settlor or any other person or body for management will stand vested in the Trust and will be subject to control and supervision of the Board.

14. Rights & Powers of Office Bearers:-

President:-

(i) The President shall look after the affairs of the Trust that the Trust runs efficiently and in accordance with the provision of the Trust deed, Rules & Regulations.

(ii) At the time of meeting of the Board of Trustees, if votes are equal in favors and in against of particulars issue the President shall exercise his casting vote.

(iii) The President shall be entitled to invite any other person to attend the meeting of the Governing Board but such person shall have no power of voting.

General Secretary:-

The General Secretary shall do all acts and deeds which may be necessary and expedient to achieve the objects of the Trust but in consultation with the President. The General Secretary shall maintain and keep all the records of the trust at the registered office of the Trust. He shall call the meeting of the board of trustees in consultation with the President. He shall records the minutes of the entire meeting and will implement resolutions thereof. He shall prepare the annual report and shall do all the other acts as may be assigned to him by the President, of the activities of the trust.

Treasurer:-

The Treasurer shall be responsible for maintaining regular and proper accounts of all receipts, payments, assets and liabilities of the Trust. He shall get accounts audited within four months of the close of the financial year and place them before the Board of Trustees. He shall do all other acts as may be assigned to him by the President.

15. BANK ACCOUNT OF THE TRUST

The trust shall deposit its funds with bank and other approved financial institutions. The bank account of the trust will be operated by President with joint signature of any one out of secretary or treasurer of the Trust.

16. BOOKS OF ACCOUNT

The trust shall maintain proper books of accounts as prescribed by the income Tax Department and closed on every 31st of March.

17. AUDIT OF ACCOUNTS

The trust shall appoint a Chartered Accountant for conducting audit of its accounts every year.

18. DURATION OF THE TRUST

The trust is irrevocable and will continue in perpetuity.

19. ADDRESS OF REGD. OFFICE

The registered office of the trust will be at Village Gangana Tehsil Gohana Distt. Sonipat (Hr) Pin-131301. The registered office may suitably be changed to better achievement of the objects of the trust. To expand the activities of this trust, the trustees may also establish the branches of the trust at any other places within India.

20. AMENDMENT TO THE TRUST

It will not be open to the trustees to amend the objects or the terms stipulated in this Indenture. If any amendment is necessary for more effective implementation of the objects, it may be made subject to 2/3 majority of the trustees.

21. NO BENEFIT TO SETTLOR, TRUSTEES AND OTHERS

Trustees will not be entitled to any remuneration save right to reimbursement of expenses incurred in the discharge of their duties. Neither the settlor, trustees nor their families, nor any member of their families nor any of their relatives or concerns in which any of these persons are interested will be entitled to any benefit prohibited by Section 13 or otherwise directly or indirectly from the Trust.

22. INDEMNITY FOR TRUSTEES

Trustees will not be personally liable for any act bona fide done on behalf of the Trust in the course of duties as a Trustee.

23. SUITS & PROCESSES

The Managing Trustee may sue and be sued in the name of the Trust.

24. The Founder shall also be one of the trustees during his life time.

25. RECORD

Board will cause a record to be kept of investments and disbursements besides a Minutes Book recording all resolutions and proceedings for every meeting duly confirmed at next meeting and attested by the chairman of the next meeting.

26. SAVING CLAUSE

If the object or any of the powers or any provision in the Trust Deed is inconsistent with requirements of law relating to Public Trust or Trusts eligible for exemption under the Income Tax Act, or any other direct tax law, such object, power or provisions will stand modified to the extent that they should accord with such law so as to continue to be eligible to be treated as a Public Charitable Trust.

27. RESOLVING DISPUTES

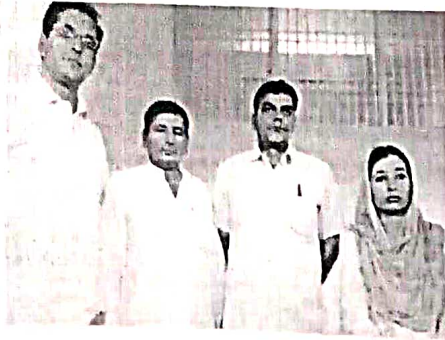
If thereby any doubt about interpretation- of this Deed or about duties, the matter shall be referred to an arbitrator chosen by a consensus among the trustees and his decision shall be accepted.

28. DISSOLUTION

In case it becomes necessary to wind up or otherwise determine this Trust for whatever reason, neither the settler nor his heirs nor the Trustees for the time being nor any other person shall have any manner of right over such funds of the Trust or any other property.

THE NET FUNDS AND OTHER ASSETS, IF ANY, AFTER MEETING ALL LIABILITIES WILL BE HANDED OVER BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE TRUST TO ANY OTHER SIMILAR REGISTERED TRUST OR INSTITUTION PURSUING SIMILAR OBJECTS.

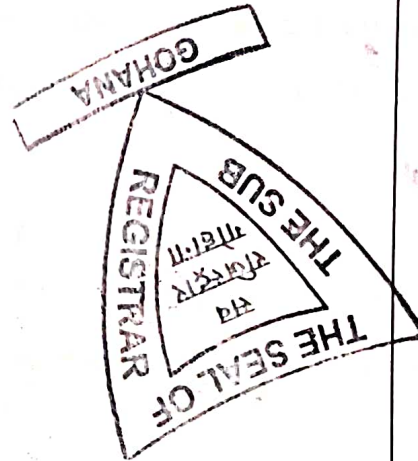

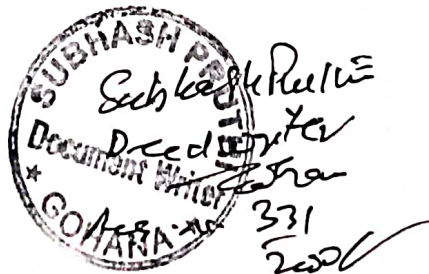
